KLOKE was established in Melbourne, Australia in 2011 by Amy Gallagher and Adam Coombes — partners in life and in Klope. They are driven by the desire to share their creativity and ideas with the world. Klope provides them with the very means to do so, offering a platform to translate their visions into tangible realities each and every day.

About

KLOKE deeply values the synergy of design and function, meticulously refining both for aesthetically pleasing, durable, and wearable collections designed to last. Their fluid seasonal concepts subtly weave in the brand narrative, celebrating individual style.

Beyond collections, they engage in diverse collaborations, from restaurants like Brae in rural Victoria to cultural institutions such as the ACMI art museum. The name KLOKE originated from the word “cloak”, which signifies something that covers or conceals, the act of disguising, or the state of being hidden. They also found a particular intrigue in the letter K and its form; its near horizontal symmetry and the

way it retained a sense of elegance, perhaps even enhanced by its sharp angles, held a certain appeal for them.

Since 2011, KLOKE has established two retail boutiques in their hometown of Melbourne. Their reach has since expanded globally, with exports now extending to Japan, Korea, Europe, China, New Zealand, the USA, and Canada.

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Responsibility

Since 2011, family-owned KLOKE has crafted detailed, high-quality, wearable garments, prioritizing fabric and construction. Their skilled in-house team handles pattern making, print design, and sampling. Committed to minimizing environmental impact, they continuously improve production and operations.

As an Australian Fashion™ certified brand, KLOKE produces at least 50% of their goods in Australia with a fully domestic workforce. They partner with long-term local makers and ensure rigorous quality control for garment longevity.

KLOKE selects manufacturing partners prioritizing high quality and strong, long-term relationships, ensuring adherence to current workplace and sustainability standards, including Sedex and BSCI certifications for international partners.

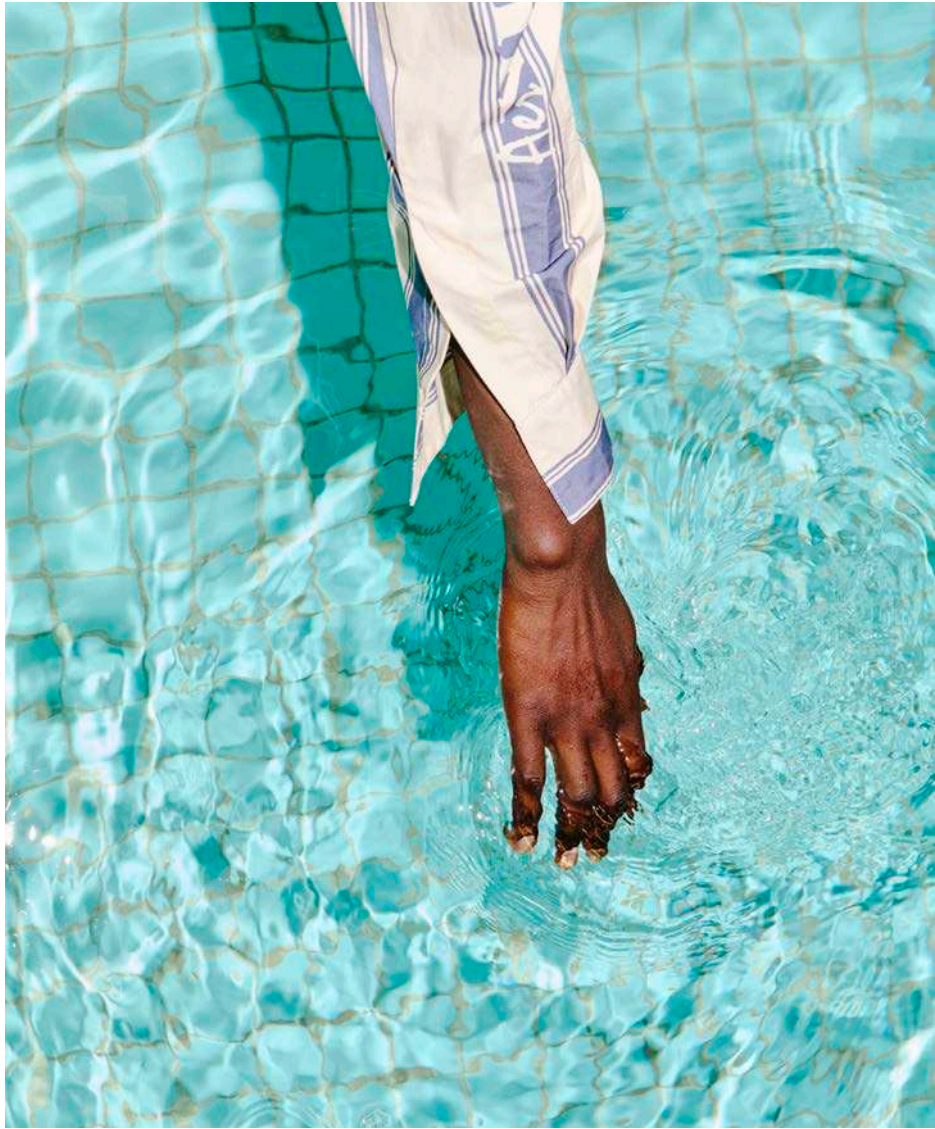




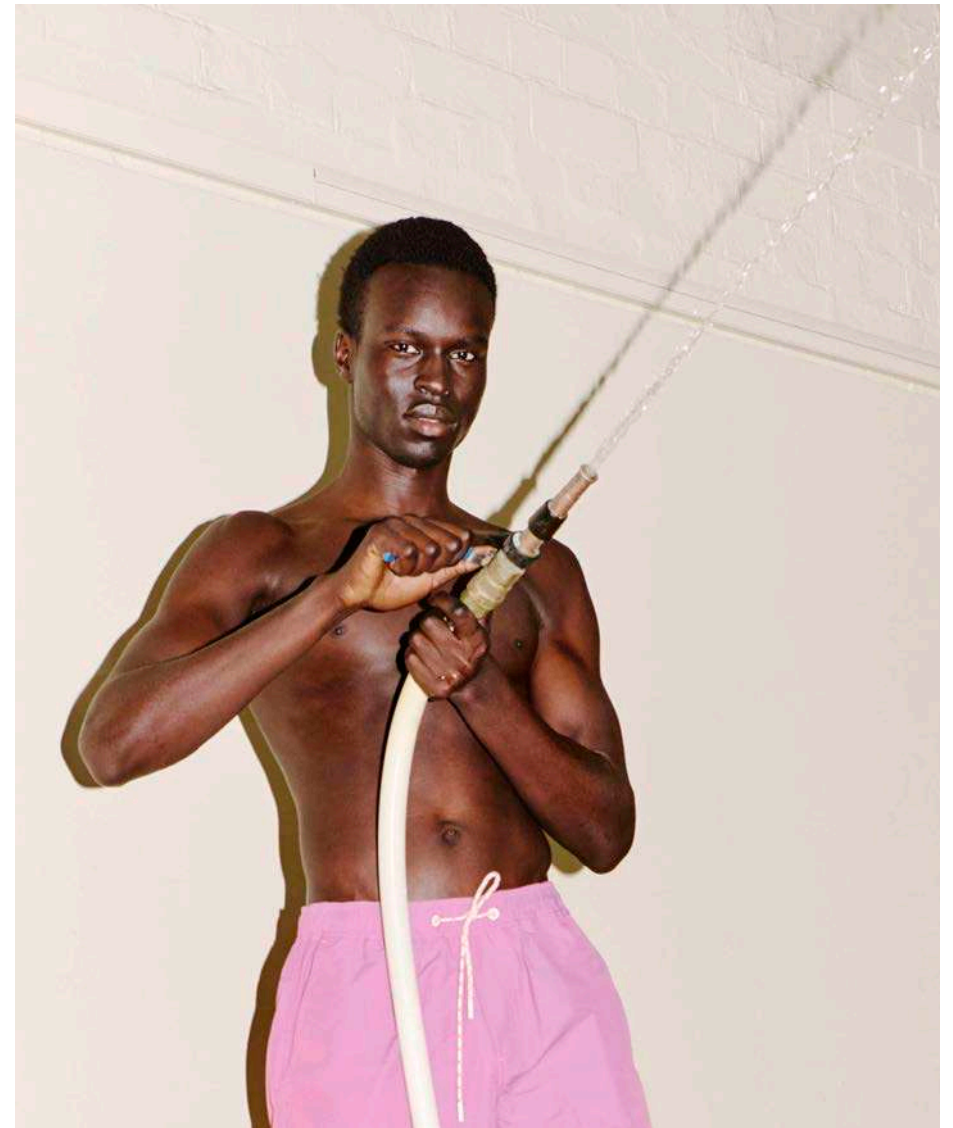








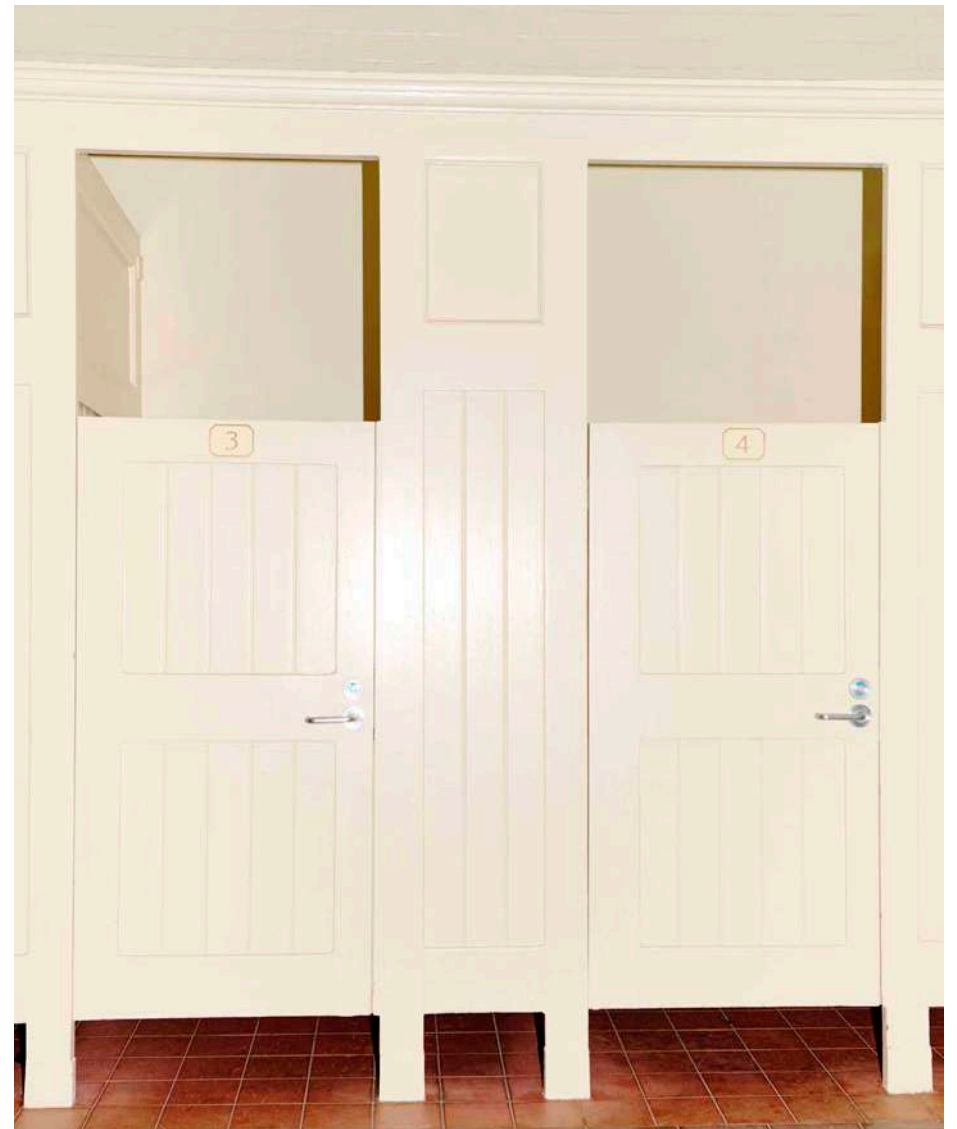












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
